## Available Degrees

### TEP (MA/Licensure or License only)

The Teacher Education Program (TEP) offers an intensive, integrated, professional preparation experience. Apprentice Teachers are in one field placement for the entire academic year, 3-5 days per week, with a gradual release of teaching responsibility over the course of the year. We encourage co-teaching, small group facilitation, and individual student support.

The Morgridge College of Education offers two distinct tracks in its outstanding teacher licensure and degree programs: Teacher Education Program (TEP) and The Denver Teacher Residency (DTR).

Both programs are renowned for their rigorous coursework, dedicated faculty, individualized support, and extensive fieldwork in culturally and linguistically diverse K-12 schools.

The TEP and DTR programs allow students to pursue a Colorado Initial Teaching License and a Master of Arts degree in Curriculum and Instruction. The Teacher Education Program offers a license-only option.
