


2021-22 MLIS PROGRAM ACHIEVEMENT DATA

One Year Retention Rates by Cohort



- RETENTION DEFINITION: Students are considered retained if they are found to be enrolled in a course, on a leave of absence, or otherwise active, but not enrolled in a course at the one year mark.


