



Candidate Competency at Completion

The Morgridge College of Education has provided initial teacher licensure exam pass rates for the following cohorts of Teacher Education Program (TEP) candidates: 2020-21, 2020-21, and 2022-23. Candidates must pass Colorado content specific exams on the first or second attempt to be considered as “passed.”

These pass rates are calculated using the following method:

- # of completers in a cohort year who passed exams / # of total completers in cohort year taking exams
