

CAEP ACCOUNTABILITY MEASURES

Candidate Competency at Completion

The Morgridge College of Education has provided teacher licensure exam pass rates for the following cohorts of the initial Teacher Education Program (TEP): 2021-22, 2022-23, and 2023-24. Candidates must pass Colorado content specific exams on the first or second attempt to be considered as "passed."

• # of completers in a cohort year who passed exams / # of total completers in cohort year taking exams
