Dear Fisher Families,

Thank you for your continued partnership and for helping us care for the health and comfort of all our children, families, and staff as we move into the cozy fall months ahead.



### **Parking Reminder**



### Pre-K Playground Updates

Thank you to all the parents and community members who raised critical funds for our Playground Campaign at the end of the 2024-2025 school year! I wanted to provide a brief update on the project and where we are in the process of refreshing our outdoor play spaces with new playground enhancements.

Our team has purchased several new items for the preschool playground. We are excited to work with DU facilities to install garden benches for the teachers, a water table, sand sensory table, double bikes, helmets, and gardening supplies. Students will use new gardening tools and a new watermill to grow seasonal items and learn about science. This will allow us to further build on our gardening grant that we were awarded - enhancing our playground and helping all kids learn.

We are waiting on a final install date from GoPlay, the manufacturer of our playground pieces. Once we get all the newly manufactured pieces delivered and installed, we would like to have a ribbon cutting to celebrate. More details to come soon.

Thank you again for supporting our playground project. Be on the lookout for some of these new items outside on the playground.
