- 1 Letter of Recommendation (uploaded by recommenders)
- Current Vita/Resume
- \$65 Application Fee

You will not submit these documents with your application. They are submitted separately to the program after admission is granted.

REQUIREMENTS FOR INTERNATIONAL APPLICANTS

International applicants, or applicants who do not hold a degree from an institution where English was the primary language of instruction, you may be required to provide additional application requirements, which are outlined below:

- Proof of English Proficiency by submitting passing TOEFL or IELTS scores
 - Minimum TOEFL Score: 80 (iBT) or 550 (paper-based)
 - Minimum IELTS Score: 6.5
